Roll and Graph Instructions



Preparation

- 1. Download and print the following pages. One page contains the dice and the other is the graph. Print out at least 1 graph page for each child that you are doing this activity with.
- 2. Cut out and assemble the dice. Make sure you insert a paper ball, 1/2 a toilet roll, or a similar object in the middle of the paper dice to give it some stability. Or laminate the dice before assembly.
- 3. If you prefer, you can also stick each of the individual pictures from the dice page onto a large foam dice instead.

How to Play

- 1. Roll the dice.
- 2. Observe which picture is facing upwards. Find the same picture on the graph worksheet.
- 3. Color in one of the rectangles above the matching picture on the graph worksheet.
- 4. Repeat steps 1 3, either until one picture has all of it's spaces filled in, or until the child has rolled the dice for a total of 10 turns.
- 5. Compare how many different times each of the pictures was rolled by looking at the filled in rectangles on your graph.
