

Instructions



Preparation:

1. Download and print the following pages
2. This step is optional - Glue the A4 pages onto a sheet of wrapping paper. (With the wrapping paper pattern facing upwards when you flip the cards over.) That way when the cards are made, you can't see through the paper to the design underneath. Wrapping paper is a cheap and easy way to give your cards this double layer.
3. Laminate and cut out each of the cards.

How to Play:

1. Shuffle the cards together.
2. Lay the cards face down, so you can't see the picture.
3. Pick 2 cards and turn them over.
4. If the cards are a matching pair, the player whose turn it is, gets to keep them.
5. If the cards do not match, then flip them back over.
6. Repeat steps 3 - 5 until all of the cards have been matched and collected.
7. The player with the most pairs of cards wins.
