



# Board Game Instructions:

## Preparation:

- Download and print the following page.
- Laminate the Board Game. This is optional, laminating the page makes it more sturdy. Which means it's easier to store and use with your class year after year.
- Another easy option is to slip the page into a sheet protector.

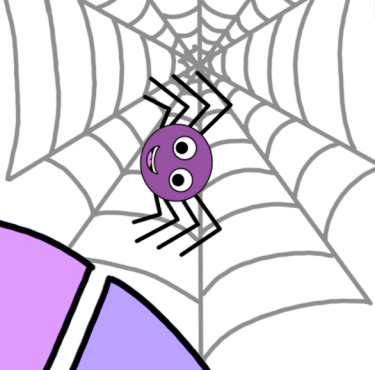
## Materials Needed:

- This Printable pdf
- A dice
- Manipulatives, (for example a glass pebble or mini eraser.) You'll need one for each player.

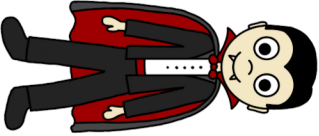
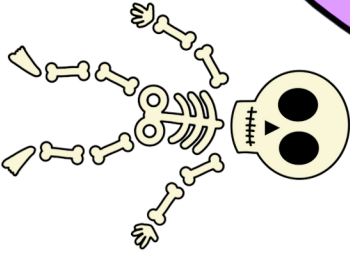
## How to Play:

1. Place your manipulative on the circle marked "Start".
2. Roll the dice and count how many dots are on the side facing upwards.
3. Move your manipulative forward the same number of spaces as is on the dice. For example, if you roll a four, then move your manipulative forward 4 spaces.
4. If you land on a step with additional numbers on it (for example +2 or -1) then move your manipulative forward or back the same number of squares as is written on the square.
  - a. For example, if you land on a square that has +2 written on it, then move forward an additional 2 squares.
  - b. If you land on a square with a -1 written on it, then move your manipulative back 1 square.
5. The first player to reach the "Finish" square, is the winner.
