Board Game Instructions:



Preparation:

- Download and print the following page.
- Laminate the Board Game. This is optional, laminating the page makes it more sturdy. Which means it's easier to store and use with your class year after year.
- Another easy option is to slip the page into a sheet protector.

Materials Needed:

- This Printable pdf
- A dice
- Manipulatives, (for example a glass pebble or mini eraser.) You'll need one for each player.

How to Play:

- 1. Place your manipulative on the circle marked "Start".
- 2. Roll the dice and count how many dots are on the side facing upwards.
- 3. Move your manipulative forward the same number of spaces as is on the dice. For example, if you roll a four, then move your manipulative forward 4 spaces.
- 4. If you land on a step with additional numbers on it (for example +2 or -1) then move your manipulative forward or back the same number of squares as is written on the square.
 - a. For example, if you land on a square that has +2 written on it, then move forward an additional 2 squares.
 - b. If you land on a square with a -1 written on it, then move your manipulative back 1 square.
- 5. The first player to reach the "Finish" square, is the winner.

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
